Preparing Students for Green Jobs

At Job Corps, all career training programs are aligned with industry-based skills and credentials. Green training is no different. Students at Job Corps have access to the latest technology and industry-based training practices in three career pathways:

Advanced Manufacturing

Machining, Manufacturing Technology, and Welding

- Manufacture and repair of green products
- Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) and Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) safety requirements

Automotive and Machine Repair

Automobile Technician, General Service Technician, and coming soon, green training in Collision Repair and Refinish

- Hybrid vehicle maintenance
- Alternative fuel systems knowledge

Construction

Bricklaying, Carpentry, Cement Masonry, Electrical, Facilities Maintenance, HVAC, Painting, and Plumbing


Saving You Time on Training
